Due to time restrictions Senior couples have to choose only one age group per discipline and day. It is not possible to compete in two age groups in the same discipline on the same day (e.g SEN I C and SEN II C – only one age group allowed).

Competing in Senior (any age group) and Adults at the same day is possible.

Once an entry has been done the change of the age group isn't possible anymore.

Dress Rules: **All Grades/Classes:**
Foreign couples are allowed to dance in the dress according to the rules of the country where the couples come from.

Syllabus: **All Age groups - Grades/Classes D, C:** according WDSF Rules

Adjudicators: **5 to 7 Adjudicators from Austria, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech** (planned)

Dancing Floor: Up to 3 floors simultaneous, 20m x 12,5m each, surface: parquet

Closing Date: **21.2.2016 strictly.** Late entries only possible in accordance with schedule!
